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
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The True Ancestors

The Perfected Adam and Eve

This speech is the whole of Book 1, Chapter 1, Section 1 of Cham Bumo Gyeong.

od created human beings to experience joy for eternity. Adam and Eve, the first ancestors of humankind, were created to be the object partners of God's absolute true love. Humanity had to originate from one ancestral couple. God created true love to flow in one stream; hence he cannot begin another stream of true love from someone other than one man and one woman. If Adam and Eve had become perfect through God's absolute love and multiplied good descendants, they could have realized an ideal family. Everyone in that family would have attended God the Creator as their vertical, incorporeal true parent and perfected Adam and Eve

as their horizontal, substantial true parents on earth.

Adam and Eve's true family would have expanded into Adam and Eve's clan. Their clan would have prospered, expanded into a society and nation and ultimately would have built a world that fulfilled God's three great blessings, to "be fruitful, to multiply and to have dominion over all things." That world would have been nothing less than the ideal kingdom of heaven that God had intended to build on earth.

From seeing Adam and Eve who were created in his image, we can understand that God exists with the dual characteristics of masculinity

and femininity. It is because God has both of these characteristics that God created Adam and Eve. Therefore, Adam and Eve needed to become one as subject partner and object partner, as a perfect man and a perfect woman. Had they done so, they would have reached a position equal to that of God. Then they would have given birth to sons and daughters and given them the same love that God gave them when creating them. Human beings were God's greatest masterpieces among all created beings. He created them so that they could also be in the position of creating such masterpieces, human beings, as their children. God therefore expected Adam and

Eve to become completely one as husband and wife. Then, when looking at the children born from their perfect union, Adam and Eve would have also felt the tremendous joy that God experienced when he created them. God imbued Adam and Eve with love that would have enabled them to give birth to children and to love them with that very love. In other words, Adam and Eve, being God's beloved children, totally received every single thing that God, the Absolute Being, had within him.

The original Adam and Eve were God's body. What I am saying is that these originally good ancestors of humanity were to be a substantial manifestation of God. God wanted to enter their minds and become one with them in physical form. In that state, even as God wanted to give them more and more, they—God and human beings—would revolve around one another. Spinning like a rotor, they would become completely one.


Had such seeds of love been sown, their descendants, humankind, would have borne the fruit. Then, no matter how far you dissected that seed, its core substance would never change. However, because of the Fall, that seed needs to be dismantled and repaired; it must be fundamentally restored, but this is impossible unless they bring God back into their lives and attend him.

God created heaven and earth in order to share his life and love. This is why God, the incorporeal one, brings forth a man and a woman as the eternal embodiments of his love. They are the True Parents, the good human ancestors, whom he now introduces to humanity as the central substance of his love.

The original Adam and Eve were to have been the True Parents. As Father and Mother, they would have been the center of the family and regarded as the king and queen of the family. Their sons and daughters would have been the heirs who could become future kings and queens. If the original ancestors, Adam and Eve, had not fallen, God would have been the grandparent who bequeathed his kingship to their family. That is why the True

Father and True Mother are the king and queen of their family and represent all families in all nations. They are the original king and queen of the family, and you as their sons and daughters are in the position of princes and princesses who will inherit their kingship in the future as members of the royal family.

Due to the Fall of the human ancestors, God lost the true ancestors of humankind as he had envisioned them according to the ideal of creation. Human beings, no matter how great or how wealthy, even if they have the power to move the entire world, are still from the lineage of the fallen ancestors. This is a most lamentable truth. People who are descended from the fallen ancestors are bound to plummet down to Satan's hell. People throughout history have been searching for the original Lord, the original parents who are the true ancestors who can embrace fallen humanity as their true children. For this, God strove to recover the positions of Adam and Eve prior to the Fall, following the path of restoration continually for four thousand years.





As public figures, as True Parents, Father and Mother have brought joy to people all over the world.

Adam and Eve, had they not fallen, would have become the true ancestors of humankind. They would have become the True Father and True Mother, the True Parents of humankind, in the flesh. However, Adam and Eve fell, and humankind became Satan's children. Suppose Adam and Eve had not fallen, but instead had become a man and woman imbued with God's heart. They would have joined in holy matrimony as God rejoiced over them and have become the True Parents of humankind. Then the created world would have united with them in harmony, and joyfully provided their family with everything they needed.

Had Adam and Eve become a true son and daughter before God, had they become a true husband and wife as the model for all human beings, and had they become the True Parents of humankind who could attend God as their eternal parent, they would have been able to sing with joy and happiness throughout their lives. No one would ever have

been able to lead them away, because they would have belonged solely to the one Lord. Their heart and their love would have belonged to the one Lord. Their one Lord would have been God.

The Fall disrupted Adam's family. Therefore, the goal of restoration, to return to the original state before the Fall, is to restore Adam's family. God first strives to recover one individual who will be his partner and then he strives to recover one central family. Only after that can he strive to recover a church, a people, a nation and then the world. Throughout history, God has been seeking a family that could become his ideal object partner. Such is the True Family. The True Family is fundamentally different in substance from ordinary families. Unless that Godcentered family can be recovered and aligned with God's ideal, there is no way to recover the ideal for the nation or the world. This is the reason that God must first establish the original True Family. Similarly, salvation

cannot be attained by individuals; rather, the basic unit of salvation is a true family.

Had it not been for the Fall, Adam and Eve would have become the ideal husband and wife and, one step further, the True Parents. They would have become the True Parents to their posterity and all the leaders, members of the headquarters. Had humanity prospered with Adam and Eve as the True Parents, they would have built one great family and established the world of peace in the Adamic cultural sphere.

The history of God's providence of restoration is a sorrowful history. The fact that God lost Adam and Eve is something to grieve over. The problem is that this loss did not end with those two individuals alone. Losing them meant losing their clan, and this lost clan has since expanded into peoples, nations and the world. By losing Adam and Eve, God lost them all. Thus, the loss of Adam and Eve meant that God's kingdom and his sovereignty were lost. It meant the loss of God's family, God's clan and the people for his kingdom. It meant the loss of the ideal for a man and woman, the loss of God's only son and daughter. That is why the history of salvation, namely the history of the providence of restoration, is to recover one man and one woman, Adam and Eve. If Adam and Eve had not fallen but had prospered, today every single human being among the many billions of people on our planet would be registered in the heavenly kingdom. Everyone would naturally enter the heavenly kingdom as one family.

Due to the fall of the first human ancestors, people could neither have true ancestors nor be true descendants. Even God could not be in the position of our True God. Nothing was centered on God, so there was no basis to build a true family, a true society or a true nation. For this reason, we must seek the true root, and when we find it, we will also find the nation in which everyone can live together as one true family. That is why, through the providence of salvation, God has sought to build one world, a world of hope, true peace, love and oneness. To realize this purpose, God sends the Savior. The True Parents must come to earth

The reason he returns is to plant his feet on the ground and find the one bride who can receive God's total love. Therefore, in the course of history, a perfect woman must emerge who is absolutely connected to God's love. She must join with the perfect man who lives in oneness with God's love. She is able to stand as the bride of the returning Lord, who comes as the bridegroom. That time is at hand.


When they unite in this position, they are at the level of Adam and Eve

Here is a beautiful scene of a brother wanting the ripples he makes

to reach his sister washing vegetables on the other side of the stream, hoping that they will touch the back of her hand. How beautiful this scene is, taking place in complete harmony with nature!

Subregion three is at the center of subregions one, two, four and five. Therefore, just like this little brother who tried to send out the ripples of water, may your devotion and determination reach out and influence all of Japan. It is my deep hope that subregion three will make effort to implement its plans.

By the end of World War II, Japan had become a country of war crimes. Yet, thanks to Korea, Japan has become an economic powerhouse. This is the historical truth. As an economic power, Japan is the world's best in packaging technology. The United States and many other countries have imitated Japan. When we receive a precious gift, the more beautiful the outer packaging is, the greater our interest in the gift becomes.

However, to see what the gift is, you must open the packaging. The value of a gift is not in its packaging, but in the gift itself. In that sense, looking at Japan, I sincerely hope that it will no longer try to package distorted truths about history or about the providence. Packaging is bound to come off at some point.

Gotoda explained how Japan came to be where it is today; it is because of Korea, where God's only begotten daughter could be born for the sake of the completion of God's providence. Japan has been able to receive forgiveness because of Korea. This is due to True Parents having been born in Korea. True Parents' Efforts to Reunite Korea

ood morning everyone. My name is Myung-chul Cho. I was a member of the Korean
National Assembly. As a legislator, I was given a nickname. I was called "the Crybaby," because every time I was asked to give a speech, I would always be moved and against my hope and desire, I would shed tears. But today, because I am coming here to Heavenly Parent's Holy Community's Peace Festival, I am again moved to tears because I want to thank and welcome every one of you peace-loving citizens who have come here. I would like to thank in particular Dr. Moon for inviting me to come and speak.

I'm not sure how many of you know me, but I would like to briefly introduce myself. In contrast to those of you seated here, my hometown is Pyongyang. I was born in Pyongyang, as was Kim Il-sung, so he and I share the same hometown. I went to Amsan School and later to Kim Il Sung University. These are educational institutions where the elite of North Korea go. After graduating from university, I was appointed as a professor of Economics at Kim Il-sung University. Thereafter, I went on an exchange program to China. From China, I came to South Korea.

When I came to South Korea, I visited the Korea Institute for International Economic Policy and began working there. Strangely, when as a North Korean I came there, when I saw how South Koreans respected me and welcomed me, I [fully] left, I became a defector from North Korea. I continued to work in South Korea until I was elected as a national assemblyman. I am also working as a professor at Sun Moon University. [Applause] Thank you. The president of Sun Moon University is also here.

I only have five minutes, so I want to end my introduction there. What I want to say is that you are genuinely blessed. You truly are blessed because from the moment you were born, from your youth all the way until your elderly years, even when you are old, you can always see Rev. Moon and Dr. Moon. You can always receive love and the truth from True Parents. You lead blessed lives.



It was at the age of thirty-two that for the first time in my life that I heard about Rev. Sun Myung Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon. It may seem insignificant to meet True Parents, but for me it was such a profound shock. I was a professor at Kim Il-sung University in North Korea at that time. My father was the minister of Construction in North Korea, and after True Parents' visit to Pyongyang, Premier Kim Il-sung called all the ministers and he told them that he had met with Rev. Moon. All the government officers were shocked.

That caused me to think, How incredible must this person be? How great must this person have been that he moved Premier Kim Il-sung? When I lived overseas and when I lived in South Korea, I saw so many people criticizing, cursing North Korea. But when I was in Pyongyang, nobody ever said, North Korea's ideology, North Korea's system is wrong. I never saw one single person tell the elite, tell the premier.... There were so

many politicians, so many businesspeople, so many NGO leaders and so many religious leaders that came to Pyongyang, but every time they came to Pyongyang, they felt over-awed. Instead of telling the truth, they would praise the North Korean system.

However, Rev. Moon was different. He told Premier Kim Il-sung that the Juche ideology is wrong, that communism is wrong—that this system that denies God is wrong. In front of the premier of North Korea, Rev. Moon confidently, boldly spoke. What an incredible, what a great person!

I'm sure you know that if you go to North Korea and say the wrong thing, if you even mar a poster, or take down a poster, or take down propaganda material or speak about God, your life might be at risk.

So many citizens from America and around the world, so many pastors and businesspeople [came and said nothing critical]. It is unbelievable, unimaginable. Many of you might think, If I go to Pyongyang, I am going to speak freely. I am going to tell the truth.

Please believe me when I say, when you go there, it is just not possible. Rev. Moon was indeed an incredible person. What I felt was that he was a great person because when everyone else criticized North Korea, when everyone else cursed North Korea, they said, North Korea should perish. North Korea should be destroyed. When everyone else cursed North Korea, Rev. Moon said, "Even though North's Korea's system is wrong, even though the Juche ideology is wrong, we need to work together to realize reunification."

At the time, when he told the truth, he also extended his hand. I was so moved by that. And when I saw Rev. Moon launching various businesses, he seriously looked at what North Korea needed—from tourism, to cars, to hotels, to economic development.

When we speak of peace and prosperity, without love, is that possible? Can we have true peace and prosperity without love, compassion? That is the person Rev. Moon is. He practiced true love and compassion.

At that time, I also met Dr. Hak Ja Han for the first time. How can she be so pure? So radiant. The citizens of Pyongyang were applauding. Some people said, [Professor Cho's hand goes to his heart] "She is lovely. She is beautiful." But what I felt is that the face is a window into the soul of a person. The fact that Mother was radiant... Looking at True Mother, I thought, How great must be True Mother's love be that she is so radiant. You have been able to see True Mother, True Parents, for your entire lives. I can tell you that the citizens of North Korea

desperately want to see True Parents, but they cannot.

When I see True Mother, Mother does not speak much, but you can see it in her countenance. I love True Parents and when True Parents do anything, an event, a gathering, I always do my best to attend. I can say that I am a fanatic when it comes to True Parents. It may be embarrassing for a political figure to say that he is a fanatic toward True Parents, but I can confidently say that.

When I see the path that True Parents have trod and the steps they've taken, it reminds me of a poem by Honorable Young-eun Han, which says, "What is a friend? You left me and beyond these beautiful gingko trees, beyond those beautiful hills, you have gone."

Rev. Moon left, but we never left Rev. Moon. He is always alive in our hearts. I have read this poem so many times when thinking of Rev. Moon, that I have memorized it. It's because of Rev. Moon, because of True Parents, that the Korean Peninsula has importance in modern history.

When Rev. Moon ascended, I was filled with concern. But after that, when I saw what Dr. Moon, what True Mother, did, I truly felt, Mother is the best! She is amazing!

Rev. Sun Myung Moon, his will, is not just being perfected, but True Mother has expanded on God's providence and made it blossom even more. I'm sure you know this even better than I do.

Look at all of the leaders from around the world that True Mother is gathering for the sake of peace, harmony and the peaceful reunification on the Korean Peninsula. No government has been able to do so. All the scholars of the world, even if they combine their wisdom together, can we say that they would achieve as much without True Parents? Mother is bringing together all of the world's scholars, and this is a sight that is not common nowadays.

Today, I heard that members of Heavenly Parent's Holy Community are increasing. This is possible thanks to True Mother. Because of that, I feel so happy and hopeful about the future.

I'm sorry. I am going over the time limit. I will take a bit more of your time. Mother needs to be with us. Mother needs to stay healthy, so that a nation like North Korea, such a dark place like North Korea, can finally see the bright light of reunification. We sing, "In the dark places, we will bring our embrace. Bring light!" Let us follow True Mother. Thank you very much. **

When I went to Liberty University in America, I was able to hear the testimonies of Rev. Jerry Falwell, the founder of Liberty University. He is a person I profoundly respect. 



ello, my name is Rumiko Yamasita and I am from Yeongwol County, Gangwon Province, Korea. I am incredibly grateful to be here today at this significant event of the Second Peace Festival and share with you a little bit about my life.

In November 1997, I was married in the forty-million-couple International Marriage Blessing hosted by our True Parents, Rev. Sun Myung Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon. Three years later, in February 2000, I moved to Korea. It has already been twenty-one years since that very cold winter day. Right now, I live with my husband, Tae-young Yun, my two sons, who are twenty and twenty-one, and my parents-in-law. Three generations live happily together under one roof. Moreover, another family lives in our barn, our thirty-five cows.

As I mentioned, three generations live together in our home. But when I first arrived in Korea, my parents-inlaw's parents were still alive, so there were four generations. Isn't that amazing? In Japan, I had worked in a bank, and lived in a family of six with my parents and three siblings. At the time I could not even imagine the tight family bonds that came with such a large four-generational family. However, it was not long before I realize what that kind of love and affection was.

When I was pregnant with my first child, my morning sickness was so severe I could not eat anything. Seeing this, my grandfather-in-law took the bus downtown to buy me hardtack. My grandmother-in-law, worried that her foreign granddaughter-in-law would have difficulty adjusting to married life to a Korean and a Korean lifestyle, cherished me and often told me funny stories. When I think about those memories my eyes still sting with tears of deep gratitude. Four years after I came to live with my husband, my grandfather-in-law suddenly passed on from this world.

After that I spent a lot of time caring for my grand-mother-in-law. She had suddenly lost her eyesight and could not see anything. She could no longer stand because her knees were bad, and on top of that she began to suffer from dementia. So, every morning I started my day cleaning Grandmother's room, which had been ruined by urine. My mother-in-law says, "No one can defy dementia." She also struggled because of Grandmother. Nevertheless, Grandmother was well cared for by our family and after three peaceful years she passed away.

Since then, I have engraved the values of family love and true happiness in the center of my heart and have focused more on my faith. Meanwhile in 2009, at a forty-day Ocean Workshop in Yeosu, I was able to discover a deeper meaning to the value of the "joy of life" which I had also engraved in my heart.

For five years beginning in 2013, I became the outreach leader at my church in Yeongwol and now I am leading several volunteer projects as the president of the church Finance Committee. During that time, I received two Devoted Daughter-in-Law Award—one from the

Yeongwol County Government through a nomination by my aunt and another from the Yeongwol Confucian School through a nomination by the president of our church's senior committee.

I received these precious Devoted Daughter-In-Law Awards, but I still feel inadequate. As you can tell, my Korean is still not perfect and cultural differences still sometimes arise. However, with the best of my efforts, if I can be recognized by my family, my neighbors and my community, and I heal even a bit of the pain that Japan inflicted on Korea in the past, I would take this path one hundred times over. Moreover, if I can give even a small amount of strength to True Parents who are exerting themselves to open the way for a true world of peace and a joy-filled future in a heavenly unified Korea, I will invest more effort as I take this path.

I endured many things throughout the past twenty-one years. Yet as a Blessed family, I walked a love-filled path striving to spread true joy, in my family, to my neighbors and to my community. I have made it to today by raising my sons into mature young adults who are proud of the path their mother has taken.

Hyojeong Encounters

This is the transcript of a speech Dr. Yun has been delivering on a recent speaking tour.

he reason I came here today is not to host a revival or to share and evaluate the international headquarters' strategies but to fulfill my duty as a filial son by giving you a sincere testimony about True Mother, whom I've attended at a close distance. I, too, am experiencing rebirth and resurrection through this hyojeong encounter. I am deeply grateful for this opportunity to express my respect to you and convey True Mother's love to you.

It is important to move forward to achieve providential goals. But I also believe it is important for us to unite, harmonize and encourage one another along the way. I think hyojeong is our essence and that hyojeong is more important than the range of our providential goals.

I would like to share Mother's heart and circumstances with my seniors and juniors in life and in the life of faith. I will do my best so that this encounter, centering on hyojeong, becomes an opportunity for me to unite and communicate with the church leaders who are working hard on the front line with humble hearts.

The UPF member stage is a stage of understanding God as our Heavenly Parent. The church member stage is the stage of understanding that we are Heavenly Parent's child. The Blessed family stage is the stage of understanding that we are Heavenly Parent's family. The Cheonbo stage is the stage of understanding that I am Heavenly Parent's treasure. We aim to attain individual perfection as a church member, family perfection as a blessed family and perfection of dominion as a Cheonbo couple. This is how we grow through the road map of faith and restoration.

In teaching me about the happiness of a community, True Mother has told me ways to make our church, our holy community, a place we want to go to and not a place we have to go to. What True Mother has taught us about the culture of our church ever since the settlement of Cheon II Guk was that our culture must become one that can embrace everything. Lately, True Mother has been hosting a Sunday service every week. What is remarkable is that she is not doing this with a rational mind, but with sensibility, or in other words, pleasure and joy rooted in a heart of true love, that wants to keep giving, a heart of longing to meet her beloved children.

Furthermore, even within the COVID-19 pandemic, she started off a special one-hundred-day course centering on the ministers. She looked into the life of each minister in order to unite and walk together with them. I observed true maternal affection as I attended Mother by her side.

Within the fortune of the settlement of Cheon II Guk, she has started the Cheonbo Education Center and has led us to the path of asceticism to perfect the three great blessings. True Mother is changing the environment and culture of our community in order to cultivate the members, not through the past pioneering path for survival's sake, but through a formal sector of training of the heart and love.

The members of Heavenly Parent's Holy Community developed their faith due to True Parents' teachings and are following the path to become true parents. Step by step, we are marching forward to become true parents of our tribes and of our countries with our faith in True Parents.

I had never seen True Mother so pleased as she was after the launching of Think Tank 2022. Her eyes welled up with tears as she thanked the members, leaders, members of the headquarters' staff



and other staff members. She said, "Thank you. Thank you so much." I cried my eyes out. I could not but cry because I knew what she had gone through. When Mother came out of a US court of law after indescribable hardships, having had to testify, I asked her, "Why do you live such a tough life? Can't you live a more relaxed life? You cannot even sleep. You wake up eight times every night. Why do you have to live like this?"

Mother's answer to my question was very clear, "Because I am Mother." I believe our brothers and sisters raise your children with the utmost care and affection. Imagine that your beloved child trampled on your heart. On seeing True Mother embracing even such behavior, I realized that our path to attend True Mother as her sons and daughters could not be other than a path of humility. I could not withdraw when Mother was willing to go on. This is my confession of faith. This was how she fulfilled the seven-year course. Her mouth was sore and her legs were swollen. It was beyond words. But she accomplished it.

I believe you remember the Blessing Ceremony True Mother hosted in South Africa. Mother had to descend to the first floor of the FNB Stadium in order to carry out the ceremony, but the owner of the stadium had turned off the electricity and blocked the elevator.

Each step of the 140 stairs Mother descended reminded me of her seven-year course, or each day of her seven-year course, or even each day of the six thousand years of fallen human history. This was how Mother achieved the condition for national restoration. This is True Mother's course.

Mother supported True Father to live like True Father, Unification Church members to live like Unification Church members and a community of the heart to live like a community of the heart. This is the way she has lived. What we need to do today is observe Mother's achievements, feel them and sympathize with them as they are and to truly attend her with our hearts. When we realize a unified Korea and a unified world within our hearts with that mindset, I am sure Heaven will support us.

Do you remember True Mother's speech? "My body could not take another step, but I had to go on and I had to show them that we could create miracles.... I felt like a lonely sailboat on the vast ocean, but I had to keep my promise to Heavenly Parent and True Father." This is True Mother's heart.


Due to this fulfillment, we saw a new dawn. Thus, when I saw True Mother accomplish the launching of Think Tank 2022, I thought not only of her seven-year course but of her life course. I may not know much, but it suddenly hit me, and I could not help crying. True Mother said, "Thank you. Thank you so much!" "I trust you. You are the heavenly treasures and you are the first to take this path opened by Heavenly Parents. I will trust you!"

This is the providence of the Cheonbo Family Church. What I would like to ask of you today is to believe in True Parents, especially True Mother, and unite as we march forward. Like the wild geese that fly, traveling thousands of miles together, let us praise and encourage one another and head for our goal as we walk together on this path of victory by becoming True Parents' doubles, their ambassadors, their representatives. \mathcal{P}

Moving from Being Blessed Families to Cheonbo Families

An interview of Director Young-hwan Gil



If we think about the 430 couples, many became closer to the church but did not actually join. How much more difficult is it to get the forty-three couples from among the 430 to become members of the church?

n Korea, I am making a model. Since it is so difficult, I am creating an organization, Pyeonghwa Aewon, which means "Peace-Loving People." We invite ambassadors for peace and UPF members that are not our church members to a Peace Festival. We then invite them to a Peace Service, and then we ask them to take part in our peace training, which is like a workshop. To a certain extent, it is easy. It is easy to meet them, easy to get to know them. If they actually join these three courses, it has been approved that they can become one's fortv-three substantial families and be seen as real members.

Normally, we should take forty-three couples from the four hundred and thirty couples. That was the original rule, but some of them live far away or are involved in their own pastoral work in other places. They are not close to us; they do not live in our area. In reality, it is not easy.

So, through this three-step process, we are creating families that are close to us, people who love

peace; and then we guide them to become members. Later, we introduce them to the Blessing. Slowly, we want them to become cheonbo citizens. This is the path that has opened for these people.

We are not just meeting people who've never had contact with us before; we are searching for them through the UPF network. It's easier for us; there is a greater possibility of success, because they are closer to us and know about us. Often, they are already prominent citizens of their village or area. In this way, members have a greater opportunity to do activities with them because they can more easily connect with each other.

What sort of attitude or mindset do we need to succeed in this work?

heart, that is completely aligned with True Mother—faith, too, aligned with True Mother. I often see that when we do not have confidence within ourselves, it becomes exceedingly difficult, but the moment we start following our True Mother's will, many miracles happen. This helps our members realize they have a lot of strength; they just need to follow True Mother. Then they start


praying at the Cheonshimwon. In this way, the members themselves begin to open their hearts more.

Of course, there is often a negative or dark side that arises when people feel they are not able to do something. They feel it is difficult because they do not have money, or they do not know the right kind of people. They become increasingly depressed, because they feel unable to accomplish it. That group or category exists. Raising forty-three couples who will follow the church or follow the movement is important, but more important than that is becoming close to those people, loving them and taking care of them. That process is important. It is the road to becoming cheonbo people, heavenly cheonbo people with a good heart.

Normally, people that have accomplished the three blessings should become cheonbo members, right? I call a person who has already reached individual perfection, who has accomplished the three blessings, "a heavenly self," leading to a heavenly family and a heavenly tribe. In order to become a heavenly self, we first must have love within our hearts. It's important to achieve the forty-three couples, but it is more important for us to be in a cheonbo family ourselves—to

have achieved the three great blessings. Of course it is important and we should want to liberate the people we bless as we work to reach those forty-three couples, which is why True Mother is helping us. We are going to create a book, "The Path of Becoming a Heavenly Cheonbo People." That is also why we need education about the Cheonshimwon and education on the Cheonbo course.

We want people that do the course sincerely and become cheonbo people. We do not want to just reach numbers. We are not working to say X number of people came. This is the work of Heavenly Parent's Holy Community.



Have you seen that kind of transformation in some of the members?

f course! I feel it a lot. Many changes have occurred because they believe in the miracle of True Mother. They understand True Mother's heart. Many of the pastors testify that there are many people who are achieving the forty-three couples and among them many are poor, impoverished. They find a way, they get support. They receive help, and they move together to achieve the forty-three couples.

The changes in the members' hearts deeply move the pastors. That's why, when she speaks to the pastors, True Mother often says, "I trust you," and she tells them, "You are the stars." When the pastors report to her, Mother says, "The reports of the pastors are a festival of stars."

That True Mother trusts the pastors scares them. They become tense and they must find a way to make a change in themselves, too, for each to become a better person. True Mother is not shouting at them and putting them down; she is lifting them up and trusting them, so they change. Having changed, when they go back to the mission field, to their churches, the members see that type of pastor and also change.

I understand that you have teaching material that you use. What are some of the main components?

wo things in Cheonbo education make up the Cheonbo Leadership School (CLS).

Alternatively, we call it the Cyber Leadership School. We use Cyber Leadership School when the learning is done online. It's being made in Korean, Japanese and English.

We meet once a month through Zoom, internationally, by region. Members study online and some people from overseas come here to gain some education. That's off-line education, but because of the Coronavirus, we aren't doing off-line education now. We are working through and supporting the Cyber Leadership School.

If you are asking what makes up

the curriculum of the Cheonbo Leadership School, I will tell you. There are three components: Cheonbo Leadership School I, II and III. In Cheonbo Leadership School I, we explain the basics—the most important points to become a member. We teach them the Divine Principle in a basic way and True Parents' life courses. We let them know what Heavenly Parents' Holy Community means.

Of course, after they have received the basics, they want to become members and receive the Blessing. We deal with that in CLS II. At that level, we want to find three people and through those three, create a home group. Once the home group is created, we teach them how to multiply home groups. So they become twelve and then they become forty-three. That is the job of CLS II.

What is CLS III about? It's for making the transition from Blessed families to Cheonbo families. They are already in Blessed families, and they have their trinity. They need to leave that level, too, using the leadership skills necessary to find 430 families and become Cheonbo families.

The most beautiful leadership in the world is coaching. Coaching is not about putting yourself out there but finding a way for the object, the person you are talking to, to achieve what he or she wants to achieve. You coach them so that they succeed. It's not about forcing them or giving them orders but helping them grow. Basically, just as True Parents have said in their speeches, it's about emptying yourself and doing everything for others, living for the sake of others. In the Cheonbo Leadership School, we stress that type of leadership. We teach that type of leadership in CLS III.

We teach the basics; we then teach them to become heavenly tribal messiahs and then to become Cheonbo families. We have created a program with good content in order for them to be able to follow the course and succeed.

Every country is different. The coaching style we use in Korea does not work with Americans, for example. The Japanese style does not work here in Korea. What does that

mean? We work to find good examples, good outcomes, in the local area. We study how different people succeeded in their localities. When I see that they need some help, we discuss ways that might help them succeed. I give them additional input to assist them.

I have helped a hundred and eighty pastors here in Korea to become successful. They write diaries. For the sake of coaching, I look through their diaries. I am helping them so that they can succeed one by one. I am now making case study books. After we see case studies from different countries—Korea, Japan, America, we will also have developed a system for what works where and how.

In your cyber school, do you teach from here or are others doing it in their own countries?

translators and we do it from here. We just do the main course. We call it flip-learning style. It's not about the teacher becoming the subject. Basically, the student becomes the subject. Instead of me teaching something, I first give the students the material and a Zoom video in English. They study the material by themselves first.

Then in the main study session, after they have studied the material, we come back together on Zoom and we study together. I support them. I am not teaching them or telling them what to do. I cannot teach them because every country and every situation is different. I just show them the principle and I find out how they manage it, how they adapt it to their country.

In the main class, we basically have people asking questions. I ask them questions about what they have done, and they report, give their presentation, and then other people ask questions of them. And those people also report. So the people in the Zoom conference can all learn about it. I just coach them. **P

FIND YOUR TRUE SELF THROUGH THE DIVINE PRINCIPLE

elcome everyone to this Sunday Peace Service. I would like to share the core teachings of the Family Federation with those who have come to this Sunday peace service. In every country in the world, the words of Exposition of the Divine Principle are becoming like salt and light. The Divine Principle reveals the existence of God and presents a clear understanding of the Creation, the Fall and salvation. When you understand the teachings of the Divine Principle, you discover your identity.

True freedom and liberation come from a true encounter with God. The Divine Principle vividly illuminates the heart of God at the time of the Creation, the sorrow of the Fall, and the pain of the providence of salvation. You will experience true encounters with God through the teachings of the Principle. The Divine Principle will open a new world for you. It will become your heart's manna and quail and your light. The Divine Principle is the truth discovered by wandering around the vast intangible world. This truth, which only Heaven had known was revealed by walking up a path of bloody hardship.

John 8:32 says, "and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free." If God is the creator of humanity, God must have had a reason for creating us. If we knew the reason, we would know the purpose of our existence, because the purpose of the Creation is the purpose of our existence. What does it say that humanity does not know for certain why it has existed so far? It suggests we do not clearly know the being that caused humanity to be on earth.

How can we know God? The way to know the intangible God is to know God's

purpose for creating by looking at all the things God has created, just as you can see the artist through his or her work. What is the reason that God created humanity? Was it because God should not be alone? The Bible says that God saw what he had made and that "it was very good." We can surmise that God created to feel joy. According to the Bible, God created man in his likeness (Genesis 1:26), blessed them and said, "Be fruitful, multiply, and have dominion over all things." (Genesis 1:28). The reason God gives blessings is because man's joy is God's joy. Just as the health and happiness of a child makes the child's parents happy. God's feels joy when man, whom he created as objects of joy, feels joy. Therefore, God created Adam and Eve in his likeness, and blessed them to create the kingdom of heaven on earth.

What is the meaning of God's blessing, "Be fruitful, multiply and have dominion over all things?" You can see that these words express God's wish. Parents love their children, hoping that they will grow up to be good and healthy. When a child has become an adult, the parents hope the child has a good partner and has many children, builds a blessed family, is respected by others, and lives well. This heart is unchanging with parents who have children. This unchanging heart of a human parent is the "heart of God", our parent, who said "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it." "Be fruitful" means to develop and let your body and mind grow. Wanting your mind to grow is wanting to become mature.

Wishing for children to become mature is wishing for them to be filial. Therefore, in this blessing from God, "be fruitful" means "love your parents." When a child grows up, he or she wants to marry. The heart wants to find a partner. God gave us that heart. That is how our bodies were created; that is how our minds were created. This is to achieve the God blessing, "to multiply." The word "multiply" means to marry, have children, to fill the earth. God blessed us to travel on the path of love, saying, "multiply." That is why people want to marry and have children. We love our husbands or we love our wives, and we love our children. We want to create a loving family and then a loving people, nation, country and world. To achieve this, we must first love our parents, love our wives or husbands, love our children and love our neighbors. This is how God's blessing, "multiply," can be fulfilled.

To "have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the air and over every living thing that moves upon the earth," means to love all the creation with the heart of loving parents, brothers, spouses and children. We must make all the creation grateful to God for creating Adam and Eve. In that way, God, who said, "Have dominion over all things" and gave man the right to do so, will also be happy.

If you love creation, you come to know that you have been raised by God's love, a love which is greater than your parents' love, the love from those who gave birth to you and raised you. That is how you meet God. Because God wants it to be like that, he said, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it; and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the air and over every living thing that moves upon the earth." (Genesis 1:28) Here, God's blessing expresses the wish that man be a being of love. These are called the "three great blessings." Realizing the three great blessings fulfills God's purpose for creating and us the purpose of a man's life.

It is not easy to live happily in the world with a good heart. Some blame the world when they cannot be happy even though they are doing good, but there is no

denying that unhappiness is created within oneself. This is because within the individual there is the original mind and an evil mind that confront and fight against each other for different purposes; the evil mind is the cause of one's unhappiness. For humans to achieve happiness, we must come out of the abnormal state of having two natures and have only one nature, which is our original state. To do that and to do good, which is what the original mind wants, we need to know why we came to have an evil mind.

We did not know clearly why we, who were supposed to have only one nature, came to have two minds. The Divine Principle teaches the cause of this misfortune, saying that Adam and Eve, the human ancestors, fell by eating the fruit of good and evil that God had commanded them not to eat. The reason Adam and Eve, who before the fall were not ashamed even though they were naked, covered their lower bodies after they ate the fruit of good and evil is because they had sinned with their lower bodies. It is human nature to cover up faults. We must reassess God's expressions in the Bible, which could only be conveyed using metaphors and symbols.

What caused Adam and eve to lose God's great love? What caused the children to separate from their loving parent? What is it that made them ignore God's warning, "for in the day that you eat of it you shall die"? What made them decide not to care about dying if they could eat the fruit of good and evil? It cannot be anything less than the temptation of love. The Fall was an act of adultery. The Bible story clearly shows this. Adultery destroys an individual's personality as well as the family, society and nation. Adultery destroyed the garden of Eden, the kingdom of God. As Jesus said, "You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires." (John 8:44) We feel ashamed of the lewdness in the human mind—traces of our ancestors' sins.

Up to this day we have thought that lewdness is simply an ethical issue for individuals, but we now know that demons and Satan are behind lewdness. So how can we leave this to be as it is? From now on, we cannot permit ourselves to live with such unrighteous desires. We must fight these sinful desires with all of our being. We have been called to this truth for this fight, to save the individual, family, nation and world. This sinful world is a world in which humanity grieves and God grieves (Genesis 6:6). Therefore, God will surely save this world, which due to the Fall has become a world of pain and sorrow.

As the prophet predicted, God sent Jesus as the Savior. The distrust of the Jewish people drove Jesus to the cross. Jesus, who came as the Savior, bore the sins of human-kind and took the path of death on the cross to save fallen humankind. "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, killing the prophets and stoning those who are sent to you! How often would I have gathered your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you would not!" (Matthew 23:37)" This was Jesus Christ's sorrowful heart. Jesus is to return to fulfill the mission that he could not realize when he first came. Jesus comes again so that we can become God's sons and daughters, who do not have original sin, people of heaven, so that God can dwell in our temple, and to achieve a nation in which no more tearful prayers nor sorrow arise toward Heaven.

We traditionally call God "Heavenly Father," but God is the oneness of father and mother, so "Heavenly Parent" is a more accurate expression. God is our Heavenly Parent because man and woman were created in God's likeness. Therefore, Jesus must come as a groom and meet his bride, the only begotten daughter, and they are together to manifest as the True Parents through the marriage supper of the Lamb. They are to declare the new, more explicit truth, saving all humankind, and finally completing the kingdom of God.

The Divine Principle is a new truth that enlightens us of the principle and purpose of existence. Luke 5:38 says, "New wine must be poured into new wineskins." ood morning!
My name is Jae-sik Lim. I am the father of nine children. Three generations live in our home. I'm Hye-kyung Cho the mother and this is our oldest daughter, Won-hwa Lim. We were blessed at the 30,000-Couple Blessing Ceremony in 1992.

ad: My brother first came to church and was doing activities; a little later, he invited me to join, and thanks to him, I received the Blessing. At first, I didn't think much about it, and I did not know much about the church. Still, since I lived and grew up with my brother, I had absolute faith and trust in what he suggested. I had just been discharged from the military at the young age of twenty-four and with my brother's encouragement, I decided to take part in the Blessing Ceremony.

om: In my case, I recall a speech from True Parents that said, 'If you live with your parents, you will be blessed', so, as soon as I received the blessing, I knew that I had to live with grandmother. The children's grandmother is very devoted to the children. When the balsam flower blooms, even if they are all asleep, she puts a flower in their hands; she does everything for them. She cuts all the best fruit and places them on a plate in front of us. From the moment I gave birth, everything from bathing to eating and dressing—she did—I only gave birth to the babies, and my mother-in-law raised them all.

One time, I asked grandmother, "Please give me a compliment." Grandmother said, "What should I compliment you for?" "Maybe you can't think of anything but I am sure there is at least one thing," I replied." She was embarrassed for having remained silent for so long, but since I kept asking her for at least one compliment, she finally said, "You seem to have done a good job giving birth to nine babies." After she said that, I cried a lot that day. I was so grateful that I fell asleep after crying for a

few hours, so all the scoldings and discouraged feelings melted away with that one message.

aughter: First of all, it is always noisy because I have so many roughhousing brothers. When I go out, I always have to fix my hair. One day I went to church and came home, no one was there. I couldn't see any of my younger brothers. It turns out, I had left them at church. Every time Mom and Dad leave the house, they say, "When mom and dad, aren't home, you and your younger brother are the parents, so don't fight with each other." Since then, I have been very nervous. Because when I see Mom and Dad fighting over something, I feel as if it is happening to me too. When my Dad scolds me, my heart





freezes. I remember thinking some days that I have to fix a situations as fast as I can before Mom or Dad return.

Dad: We make certain plans for our children's futures, but as we were raising them, things didn't always go our way. They grew up as second-generation members, and we want them to receive the Blessing, hopefully with another second-generation member that has faith. First of all, we hope that they will receive blessing and follow the same path we did, the path of creating a happy family.

Daughter: After graduating from university and living a social life, I feel grateful that my parents can lead a harmonious family. I feel privileged. If they said something like this before, it didn't make sense to me. However, as I was working, I realized that "My parents must have felt like this." Especially when I started working, it was really hard at first. So, I felt the feelings of my parents, and when I looked around, I saw that there are many divorced families. I came to realize that in our church family, the divorce rate is extremely low compared to society.' I think that when we come to realize such things, we are satisfied and want to keep our family close and live a harmonious life.

om: We always speak kind words for our family members so that there may be love in the family, the love of a couple, the love of parents, the love of brothers and sisters, in this family. We feel that what we learn through life itself is not something we can teach or learn somewhere else. These children, whether they liked it or not, grew up together and learned together. That's what we feel as parents. No matter how harsh the world is, I want to live a good life. If you live a good life, the end will be good. So, as long as we live with kindness, we can feel that Heaven is always with us wherever we are. God is with us even now. Feeling and receiv-

ing these blessings, we cannot deny our True Parents. Because that's how we met, so the children actually can't go anywhere else, they are the product of this amazing Blessing and life.

Jim Rogers Speaks on the Korea–Japan Tunnel Project

On September 16, 2019, Jim Rogers, the famous investor who has developed a keen interest in Korea and in some of True Parents' projects, visited the city of Karatsu in Saga Prefecture, Japan to learn about the Korea—Japan undersea tunnel project and to tour the beginning section of the tunnel, which already exists. What follows is an interview of him the following day during which he spoke of his impression of the project and its potential value.

Yesterday, you showed us a picture of your daughter. What is your family like?

he most important thing in my life right now are my children. I never wanted to have children. I thought children were a terrible waste of time, money and energy. I was never ever going to have children. I felt sorry for people who had children. Well, I was wrong. I was one hundred percent wrong. So now, my children are the single most important thing in my life.

You've traveled around the world twice. When will you next travel around the world with your children?

ell, when this tunnel is built, I want to drive from Tokyo to London with my children. I hope my children are growing up to be adventuresome, like I am... or was. So, I certainly hope that as soon as the tunnel is finished, I will be one of the first to drive from Tokyo to London.

Yesterday, you inspected the site of the Korea-Japan

Undersea Tunnel. How do you rate it as an investment target?

he projections are,

apparently, that it can pay for itself, that it can be profitable. That's the most important consideration. You don't want to burden other people with debt. In English it's called "project finance." In other words, the project itself will pay for itself. That is a very good kind of investment. The Koreans don't want to have a lot of debt. The Japanese don't want to have a lot of debt. So with project finance, if it pays for itself, it's fabulous. It's great. That's the kind of investing you need to look for, especially with infrastructure.

Do you think you could benefit from this project?

hat's what the financial people who did studies show [that investors gain profits]. I have not done the studies myself. I know it's possible. Will it work? I don't know. The engineers say it is possible to do it. The geologists say it is possible to do it and the financial people say it is possible to do it. I have not done my own independent research on any of it, but the experts tell me it is possible.

You said the Japan-Korea Undersea Tunnel is one of the most exciting projects, but...

or this part of the twenty-first century, absolutely putting a tunnel between Korea and Japan has to be very exciting. It opens up Japan. It opens up Korea more. It will bring the two countries closer together. It has got to be one of the best things happening right now.

What might be the impact of the Korea-Japan Undersea Tunnel on Korea and Japan?

f course, it will help a lot if all you have to do is get in your car and drive to the other country! That makes it very easy. Otherwise, you have to go to the airport, get a ticket and blah, blah, blah.... If you can just say, Let's go for a drive and then drive, it will change lots of things, lots of people's mentality especially in the southern part of Japan and the southern part of Korea.

Can this project revive Japanese society?

f course, it will help a lot. A building project like this brings lots of jobs in the first place and once it's open it brings new opportunities for travel, tourism, commerce—for everything. A project like this... These things

don't come along very often in history. We've had them before—in England with the tunnel between Dover and France. But these things don't happen very often. This is a huge project. It will change geography and it will change history. Geography does not change very often. This will change geography.

High political barriers remain to realizing this project. How might we overcome them?

he most important thing, in my view, is to make sure people know that it is not going to cause debt. The Japanese right now have too much debt and many Japanese people know that. So you have to show them that it is not going to add to your life's burden or your children's burden in the future.

After that, you have to show the benefits for tourism, for commerce, for trade and for everything else. I don't know how you do that. I guess we could go back and see how the English and the French did it when they built their tunnel. Somehow, they convinced people it was good.

So, first make sure people know that it is not going to cost them any money, it's not going to cost Japanese taxpayers; it's not going to cost Korean taxpayers. It is going to be a benefit in the end and they [the

taxpayers] don't have to pay for it. The project will pay for it.

I don't know why politicians are against it. That's what's confusing to me, because to me it is so clear that this is good for the world; this is good for both countries. I don't see why any politician would be against something like this. Maybe you should sit down and speak to them and ask, Why is this bad? Because I cannot see any reason that it is bad.

I guess the ports might say it is bad for the ports, but it brings so much extra business to the port of a different kind—maybe not as many ships would go in and out of the port but it would bring lots more business of other kinds because more people and more transit can go through the port. Maybe it's not on boats, but it is an increased volume of traffic, so shopkeepers and other people would have much more business.

As far as making money, as far as projections, somebody can sit down and do the financial projections. I haven't. I'm too lazy, but somebody who is smarter than I am can do it. If you have good projections based on good [financial] principles, you should show that to the world. Then, usually, you can raise money in the markets, especially project finance, if you have good numbers and good principles.

What would you estimate is the significance of the Korea-Japan undersea tunnel and the International Highway Project in the twenty-first century?

thas a lot to do with it [development in the twenty-first century], because now you bring Japan closer to Asia and more integrated into Asia. The thirty-eighth parallel is opening up, so this is going to open up Northeast Asia, especially those two countries [the two Koreas] that have been somewhat closed—they bite each other sometimes. But two countries that have been somewhat closed will be much more open.

You know, people in London are going to drive to Tokyo, too. It's not going to be everybody coming from Asia to Europe. Many people from the rest of the world... Right now, it's impossible to drive from Tokyo to London. But with the thirty-eighth parallel coming down, China opening up, Russia opening up, you're going to see more and more people—crazy people like me—traveling to see these countries. For
