Warm greetings!
True Mother reorganized our movement on May 9, and instructed us to

bring all the global foundation of the Universal Peace Federation (UPF), which True Parents have cultivated so far, to Korea and invest it in a movement for the peaceful unification of North and South Korea. We aim to launch a massive unification movement, with goals such as securing one million peace ambassadors, ten million supporters, and training 12,000 unification instructors.

Unification of North and South Korea is our destiny, and the final battle towards the completion of Heaven's providence. It will be a major battle between our ideology of Godism and the Juche ideology, which is the epitome of atheistic materialism that denies the existence of God. The process of unification must be free and peaceful, with the South and the North living together.

In 1991, True Parents visited North Korea and met with President Kim II Sung. They agreed that we must transcend ideology and system for the South and North to become one. The core contents of their plan were an inviolability pact between South and North, and the peaceful use of North Korean nuclear power.

True Parents proposed to seek a way for the South and North to live together, beyond system and ideology, saying, "Blood is thicker than water." They also agreed that the issue of 10 million separated families was the most important issue, a humanitarian issue that should be urgently resolved unconditionally.

At this point, the South and North must open the window of dialogue unconditionally and start non-political exchanges, such as humanitarian aid projects, cultural exchanges such as tourism and sports, and economic cooperation. When South Korea's economic and technological power combines with North Korea's vast resources and high-quality labor, North Korea could enter the ranks of middle-income countries within 10 years. At the same time, when the South and North are unified, the Korean Peninsula will become a country comparable to Germany, France, or the United Kingdom in terms of land size, economic power, and military power.

The basic unification plan of True Parents is the Unification Theory of True Love. On one hand, it criticizes the fallacies and vulnerabilities of North Korea's Juche ideology and proposes alternatives, while on the other hand, it emphasizes that we need to pour out true love unconditionally to our North Korean brethren with the spirit of 'food is love.'

This is reminiscent of Jacob giving everything he had, unconditionally, to his brother Esau, who intended to kill him. Esau's hardened heart melted, leading to a warm reunion between brothers who were once enemies. The relationship between the South and the North is the same. When the people of South Korea love the people of North Korea more than they love themselves, and the people of North Korea love the people of South Korea more than they love themselves, the true unification of true love will come like an avalanche.

It has been said, 'Jin In Sa Dae Cheon Myung' (진인사대천명 - 盡人事待天命): If people on earth make their utmost effort, the grand drama of unification according to God's providence will unfold splendidly before us.

Respected worldwide leaders, beloved blessed family members! This moment marks the juncture when we must march forward, forward, forward, pledging to advance towards Vision 2025 for the day desired by True Parents! Let us remember that we are now at the forefront, align ourselves 24 hours a day with the providence of True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind, and become unification warriors who welcome the momentum of unifying the heavenly homeland in our lifetime! ivilizations emerge on peninsulas. Peninsulas provide the venue for an oceanic civilization and a continental civilization to fuse together and develop into a new civilization. This is how civilizations flourished on the Greek, Italian and Iberian peninsulas. Currently, Indochina and Korea are the world's two peninsulas that are raising global issues. In the flow of global fortune, Western and Eastern civilizations are merging and are bound to meet. Where will they clash? Based on the worldwide flow of fortune, they will clash in the sphere of Pacific Rim civilization,

particularly at a central point where an island, a peninsula and a continent meet. The Korean peninsula is the central point defined by these geographical components. It is an undeniable fact of geography.

The trials and tribulations of the Korean people do not just have to do with them as a people; they are also providential. Therefore, God is eager for this people to overcome them. It can be said that all the strands of world history meet on the Korean peninsula. East and West, North and South, spirit and matter, idealism and materialism—the entire inheritance of world history

converges there in a confrontation fraught with confusion and chaos. The maelstrom on this peninsula is like the contractions of a woman in labor; she is carrying a new age in her womb. My view is that the difficulties the Korean people and nation currently face cannot be resolved apart from God's Will and providence. Furthermore, Korea cannot resolve them on its own but only by relating with the world. Hence, the Korean people should awaken to God's Will. They will overcome their hardships if they follow the one whom God has sent, the one with the mission to lead the spiritual spheres of the world.

Global civilization most certainly will come to Asia. The era of the Pacific Rim civilization is approaching. Today eminent scholars, not only in the field of social science but across the scientific disciplines, assert that a Pacific Rim civilization must appear, that it is the trend of history. Yet I have been teaching about the coming era of the Pacific Rim civilization for more than forty years now. These scholars still do not know which nation will take the lead in creating that civilization. To my mind, it is Korea that will have to take the lead.

In a situation in which the United States, Japan, Korea, China and Russia are drawn inexorably onto the battlefield, the countries that are unprepared for this civilization and culture will fall behind. I am the very man who has made preparations. I am standing on the front line. That is why I brought together Japan, the United States, China and Russia. It gives us hope to think that the American people will walk hand in hand with me and we will do great things together, as a condition for the United States and for the world to build a realm of common destiny with the Pacific Rim civilization

What is our vision as we look toward the twenty-first century? It is a vision of world peace and unity, a vision of one unified world. The world's people are seeking a new, unified and peaceful world. The Korean people are seeking the unification of North and South Korea. What about each of you? Suppose the world were peaceful and flourishing, but our nation remained divided and under threat of danger. In that case, our nation would have nothing to do with the world's peace. Likewise, suppose North and South Korea were peaceful, but our minds and bodies remained in conflict. In that case, the unified Korea would not be our ideal nation. That is why we have to attain peace on the national level before we talk about world peace; likewise, we have to attain peace on the individual level before we talk about it with regard to our nation.


Once we recover the nation that God is seeking, the restoration of the world will take place rapidly. After restoring one nation we can restore three more nations; this adds up to four nations, which will form a four-position foundation. It will be a wall of global defense facing all four directions, which Satan cannot penetrate. Only then can a world of peace be built, a world with the fertile soil for heaven to finally flourish. Such is the original homeland that the Unification Church is striving to recover. We Unificationists are gathered to invest our passion and youth for this cause. Although the evil forces that are attempting to block us are strong, we will shatter them, dismantle them, and uproot them

completely. Let us resolve to do so, and eradicate them once and for all.

The path of history is stained with blood. Your life as a pioneer on that path may have been sorrowful and miserable. However, if you walk that path not for your own sake but as Heaven's emissary, seeking to liberate people and build peace in the world, you will be remembered for eons. Your achievements will shine brightly as the foundation upon which North-South unification will naturally take place. Then a new sound of freedom will ring out across Asia. From that point will spring a new energy that will bring liberation to the world.

Our task is to unify the homeland. It is our destiny and the great task for which we must devote our entire life. I have dedicated myself to this great task, according to God's Will. For the remainder of my life as well, I shall devote myself entirely and exclusively to accomplishing God's Will. I appeal to you, the seventy million people of North and South Korea who wish for unification, to stop the discord and fighting, and from this time forth to devote yourselves to recovering your identity as one people through harmony and love. Now is the time to melt your guns and swords and turn them into hoes and plowshares, and hasten preparations to welcome the bright new era of the unified homeland. 7

True Peace

he Creator, our Heavenly Parent, created all things in the divine image, and gave the man and woman who were to become the ancestors of humankind time to grow. This was a period of growth during which they were to perfect their characters. Yet they who were to become our first ancestors failed to keep the heavenly commandment and fell. They were driven out of Eden and multiplied to form today's fallen humanity. In order to achieve without fail, together with humankind, the dream he envisioned according to the Principle of Creation, God had to undertake the work of restoration through indemnity, the providence of salvation.

God chose the people of Israel and, through Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, restored a lineage he could embrace. Heavenly Parent waited for the time to create the right environment in the nation, and finally after four thousand years, brought forth his only begotten Son, Jesus Christ.

According to the Principle of Creation, God's will cannot be achieved through the only begotten Son alone. In order to see the completion of the heavenly providence, the only begotten Daughter who did not appear 2,000 years ago must emerge. It is unfortunate, however, that at this time when we are busy with Heaven's providence and when every hour counts, I have found it so hard to speak even in the simplest terms in order to overcome 53 years of ignorance.

Do you believe that I am the only begotten Daughter of God? You could not be here in this place if you had not met the only begotten Daughter. Somehow, we must embrace Christianity and come together to achieve national restoration.

The Family Federation and UPF must tell the truth: Heaven will not wait any longer. This means you must fulfill your responsibility. If, as the chosen people, you fail to fulfill your responsibility, indemnity will follow. None of us wants to see such an outcome. That is why we must witness. Hence, in the Cheon Il Guk era, rather than lecturing on the Divine Principle, you must explain the original essence of the Creator and of Jesus, and give presentations about what you are accomplishing with the only begotten Daughter, True Mother.



n July 22nd, Cambodia's Sokha Phnom Penh Hotel played host to the International Leadership Conference (ILC) centered around "Peace and Democracy". Opening Remarks

urrently, conflicts and civil wars occur in at least 27 places throughout the world, according to the Council on Foreign Relations' Global Conflict Tracker. Even with UN involvement, these problems cannot be resolved. A prime example is the war between Russia and Ukraine, which the UN has been unable to stop. Almost 10 million people have left their homes and are suffering due to this war. The same can be said for Syria and Venezuela. Globally, as many as 95 million people

have lost their homes and are wandering as refugees. Conflicts between religions, ideologies, and races are the main causes of civil wars and regional conflicts. As UPF Co-Founders Rev. and Dr. Moon teach that conflict and evil started at the very beginning of human history. Our first human ancestors violated the fundamental principle of goodness. Instead of living for the sake of others, they created selfishness within individuals, families, races, and nations. Knowing the Creator, our Heavenly Parent, is the beginning of peace, Father and Mother Moon have advocated three guidelines that educational institutions should establish to nurture future leaders. These are: love God, love humanity, and love your country. First, to "love God" starts with honoring your parents. This creates a heart of filial piety in children and they naturally develop a character of goodness. Second, "love humanity" means to love people by loving your neighbors as your own brothers or sisters. When we all love each other like this, there will be more compassion and less conflict or war. Third, "love your country" means to live for something greater than self-serving material interests. Individuals live for families; families for the well-being of the nation; and nations for global peace. This is the world of goodness we all desire. The Universal Peace Federation advocates believes that the path to a peaceful world in our time is based on the principles of interdependence, mutual prosperity, and universally shared values.

SESSION 3

'Peace Initiative Declaration' and 'Presidency Handover Ceremony for the International Parliament for Tolerance and Peace' (IPTP)

he third session began with Dr. Michael Jenkins, Chairman of UPF USA, presenting a 'Peace Initiative.' This led into a series of focused talks by other experts. Dr. Chheang Vannarith, President of the Asia Vision Institute (AVI), spoke about the 'Universal Peace Charter,' while Dr. Cheng Kimlong, Executive Vice-President of AVI, discussed 'Cambodian Peace and Reconciliation.' Other notable speakers included Hon. Ross Robertson, former Deputy Speaker of the Parliament of New Zealand; Hon. Patricia Lalonde, a former Member of the European Parliament from France (2017-2019); and Rev. Masaichi Hori, the Regional President of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) in the Asia-Pacific region.

The session concluded with the 'Presidency Handover Ceremony' for the International Parliament for Tolerance and Peace (IPTP). This event was chaired by Hon. Khuon Sudary, who is the Chairperson of the Asian Culture Council (ACC) and also serves as the Vice-President of the National Assembly of Cambodia. Ahmed bin Mohamed Al Jarwan, President of the Global Council for Tolerance and Peace (GCTP), stepped down as President of IPTP. He was succeeded by Suos Yara, who is the Chairman of the Foreign Affairs Committee in the Cambodian Parliament.

Cambodia's Election: A Glimpse into Democracy and Transition



or 38 years, since 1985, Prime Minister Hun Sen of the Cambodian People's Party (CPP) has held his position. On July 23rd, leading up to Cambodia's 7th general election, he called upon the international community to ensure a transparent and fair election process. Responding, the Cambodian government welcomed 423 election observers from 54 nations. Notably, the Universal Peace Federation (UPF) — recognized by the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) — sent 125 members as part of this delegation. The primary aim? To ensure Cambodia's elections maintain democratic integrity, transparency, and bolster Asian peace and collaboration.

Since democracy was reinstated in 1993, Cambodia's general elections have followed a process. They select 125 parliamentary members from 18 parties via a proportional representation system, covering the capital and 25 regional areas.

The 7th Cambodian general election stirred speculation. Many saw it as a shift of power from Hun Sen to his eldest son, casting a shadow of skepticism internationally. But, delving deeper reveals Hun Sen's broader vision. It wasn't about mere power transition. He championed consistent political, economic, and social policies, underlining stable economic growth.







Looking ahead, Cambodia's government is on the brink of an economic revival. Factors like conquering the COVID-19 pandemic and rejuvenating the tourism sector fuel this optimism. Additionally, they plan to progress in areas such as advancing from the Least Developed Countries (LDC) status, economic diversification, embracing the digital shift, and countering climate change.

Early on, True Father said, "The Korean people, as a singular race, have been infringed upon by Westerners and have faced violations from cold-climate civilizations, tropical civilizations, and temperate civilizations. The current Korean situation is at the global focal point. This involves the US, the Soviet Union, and Asia. We must recognize that the civilizations of Asia, the democratic world, and the communist world are all tied to Korea. This means that in Korea, civilizations such as the tropical, Indian, Buddhist, Confucian, temperate, Western, and cold regions are all present."

After True Father's Seonghwa, during True Mother's global tour to establish a foundation for the heavenly world, she emphasized 'her last promise with the Heavenly Parent and True Father.' Despite her profound fatigue, she continues to honor her vow to see things through in her lifetime. Even when her lips crack from exhaustion, her legs swell and refuse to move, she speaks of the truth of Heaven's providence in human civilization, the stature and essence of the only begotten daughter, True Mother, and her responsibilities. She declared the Heavenly Parent's Holy Community and 'God' as the 'Heavenly Parent.' Also, in this era, with humanity, united with the only begotten daughter, True Mother, is inheriting the heart of true filial piety to realize the unification of the Korean peninsula and a heavenly unified world according to the will of the Heavenly Parent.

As we approach the historic transition of establishing a new order centered on the Asia-Pacific region, Cambodia's general elections play an instrumental role.

On the day of the Cambodian general elections, numerous current and former leaders, who traveled long distances for the Cambodia election observer delegation, reflected on the profound meaning of True Mother's genuine peace at the challenging site. They expressed their hopes for the swift realization of the dream of the Heavenly Parent and the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humanity, successfully concluding the mission. \mathcal{P}





Song Yong-cheon's FFWPU-International World Tour: Heavenly Continent of Asia

From July 20th to 29th, Song Yong-cheon, the President of FFWPU-International and his global tour team embarked on the FFWPU Heavenly Continent of Asia tour. The tour's highlights included the International Leadership Conference (ILC) in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, and Manila, Philippines, observation of the Cambodian general elections, the Heavenly Asia-Pacific leaders' assembly, the IAYSP assembly, and a special gathering with members.

Heavenly Asia-Pacific Leadership Assembly

fter the ILC and election observations in Cambodia, the Heavenly Asia-Pacific Leadership Assembly was convened. The opening ceremony progressed with a welcome speech by Hori Masaichi, the President and Continental Director of Heavenly Asia-Pacific, an opening address by Robert Kittel, the Cheon Eui Won Chair of Heavenly Asia-Pacific, a special message by Yang Chang-sik, the Chairman of UPF International and Hori Moriko, the WFWP Chairwoman, and a special report by Matsuda Koji, the President of IAYSP International. Special messages and reports were also presented by key members of the FFWPU and affiliated organizations.

Session, I focused on the status reports and best practices of the major continental organizations, including FFWPU, UPF, WFWP, and IAYSP. It provided insights into major continental organizations' status and practices. The Continental Director reported on the status, challenges, and measures of Heavenly Asia-Pacific FFWPU, emphasizing Heavenly Asia-Pacific's aspirations to collaborate closely with international headquarters, ensuring financial transparency, and enhancing individual religious education and growth through processes and workshops to achieve the results that the True Mother has spoken of.

Ek Nath Dhakal, Chairman of the Heavenly Asia-Pacific UPF and Vipa Thaveetermsakul from Heavenly Asia-Pacific WFWP conveyed that "UPF and WFWP", as affiliated organizations of FFWPU, will collaborate with relevant institutions to promote the unification of the Korean peninsula as well as world peace, by organizing diverse education programs, workshops, volunteer activities, and seminars." They also shared their will to drive a systematic development plan to fulfill the intentions of the vision of the Heavenly Parent and True Mother for the Heavenly Asia-Pacific.

Mr. Ronnie Sodusta, the President of IAYSP for Heavenly Asia-Pacific proposed a future policy direction, expressing that IAYSP will create materials that inspire and educate young people, emphasizing the importance of their dreams and developing their skills for the future.

Session II, Part 1, covered "Witnessing and Church Growth Strategy". The Continental Director first presented an overarching strategic plan. Subsequent presentations focused on witnessing and church growth strategies in Christian-majority countries like the Philippines, Australia and Oceania,

Malaysia, Indonesia, Pakistan, and Central Asia.

Leo Angelo Halog, the head of FFWPU Philippines, shared his 2023 plans and highlighted the positive impact of the Philippine Cheon Shim Prayer and Cheon Bo Workshop. Meanwhile, the head of IAYSP for Heavenly-Asia Pacific explained that their 'Patriotic Youth Program' has fostered a strong bond with the Philippine government and NGOs, benefiting FFWPU's educational and community programs.

Yutaka Yamada, Sub-Regional Director, FFWPU-Oceania and Australia, spoke about New Hope Academy. This school stands out because it follows the True Parents' values of loving God, humanity, and country. While there are many other schools, New Hope is favored for its clean setting, cohesive culture, and value-based education. This approach has fostered trust within the community. Founded on True Mother's vision, the school was officially recognized in 2019, giving it full control over its operations, curriculum, staff hiring, and finances. This approach aligns with their broader

In the second segment, they discussed outreach strategies in Muslim-majority countries such as Malaysia, Indonesia, Pakistan, and Central Asia. There's growing global attention on the HJ Heaven and Earth CheonBo Training Center. Reena Dass, who currently leads the Pakistan chapter as acting National Leader, talked about the Urdu translation of the Exposition of the Divine Principle. The day concluded with a ceremony where new national chairpersons were appointed.

During his closing remarks, Hori Masaichi thanked the leaders for their strategic planning focused on True Mother. He emphasized the urgency, saying, "We have limited time. We must promptly show tangible results to True Mother." He then encouraged everyone, "Our path is clear: we must continue to progress with dedication to True Mother. Let's head back with good fortune and give it our all."

Mr. Ronnie Sodusta, the regional IAYSP leader, mentioned how during a typhoon in the Philippines, True Mother provided significant support via an online event called the Youth Hope Forward Assembly. Vision 2025: Towards Peaceful Reunification of the Korean Peninsula

he year 2023 holds special significance for Koreans. It marks the 70th anniversary of the signing of the Korean War armistice and the Korea-US Mutual Defense Treaty. The True Parents prophesied early on that communism would not last more than 70 years. In reality, the Bolshevik Revolution of 1917 led to the formation of the first communist state, the Soviet Union, on December 30, 1922. It was dissolved 68 years, 11 months, and 26 days later; on December 26, 1991, President Mikhail Gorbachev declared the dissolution of the federation. After World War II, four countries were divided, including Germany, Vietnam, Yemen and Korea. Later, all but Korea were united. Germany was united under a free democratic system, while Vietnam was united under socialist ideology. The end of World War II brought Korea's liberation from 36 years of Japanese colonial rule. Yet the Korean people, who had been a single ethnic group for 1,300 years, became a sacrificial pawn in the power struggles of the major powers, resulting in the division of the country into North and South.









According to God's providence, the Korean Peninsula is the third Israel, the homeland of faith where the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind were born, and the land of the chosen people. Therefore, we need to analyze the background and the course of modern Korean history to gain a deeper understanding of the providential significance of the unification of Heavenly Korea, which is the hope of the members of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification.

The United States had requested the Soviet Union's participation in the war against Japan, to help defeat Japanese forces in the Manchuria region of China and prevent a protracted war. However, the Soviet Union hesitated, citing its defense treaty with Japan. But when the United States dropped its first atomic bomb on Hiroshima on August 6, 1945, the tide of war had clearly turned. The Soviet Union unilaterally declared war on Japan on August 9 and began its invasion of Manchuria the next day. Later that day the United States dropped a second atomic bomb, on Nagasaki. By August 10 the Soviet Union had already entered the Korean Peninsula. The United States was caught by surprise when the Soviet Union occupied all of North Korea, which was defenseless, in just a month. The Soviet Union had always coveted the northern part of the Korean Peninsula, in search of a port that would not freeze in winter.

When Emperor Hirohito of Japan declared unconditional surrender on August 15, 1945, the main forces of the U.S. military were stationed in the Philippines and Okinawa. The United States, alarmed at the sudden entry of the Soviet Union into the Korean Peninsula, immediately began negotiations with the Soviets. They proposed that each would accept Japan's surrender and establish a military presence along the 38th parallel, with the Soviets to the north and the Americans to the south. The Soviets accepted this proposal. They already occupied North Korea at the time, but it was not until September 9 that the United States entered South Korea. From then on, the United States and the Soviet Union each managed a separate part of the Korean Peninsula. The Soviets established a socialist regime in North Korea, installing the young Kim Sung-ju, who had been a communist guerrilla fighter, as the leader under a new name, Kim II-Sung. In South Korea, Syngman Rhee, who had been leading an independence movement based in the United States, returned to his home country to prepare for the establishment of a new nation.











Eventually, on August 15, 1948, a free democratic country was established south of the 38th parallel with the United States as its ally, and on September 9, 1948, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea was established north of the 38th parallel with the support of the Soviet Union and China, solidifying the division. With Japan's defeat, and a new government installed in South Korea, the U.S. military that had been stationed on the Korean Peninsula withdrew in 1949. In January 1950, the United States declared the so-called Acheson Line as its line of defense in the Far East. The defense parameter protected Japan and the Philippines, but excluded the Korean Peninsula. Twenty-one months after the establishment of the Democratic People's Republic, on June 25, 1950, the North Korean army made a surprise invasion of South Korea. They captured Seoul in three days, and occupied the Nakdong River area, in the far south, within a month.

The United Nations immediately convened a Security Council meeting and decided to dispatch U.N. forces to South Korea. Under the order of U.S. President Harry Truman, General Douglas MacArthur, the commander of the Far East Army, was instructed to defend South Korea, and U.S. forces arrived on July 1, one week after the start of the war. This was the first decision to dispatch U.N. forces since the formation of the United Nations in 1948. It was a unanimous decision, as the Soviet Union, one of the five permanent members, did not attend the meeting. There is a theory that the reason for the Soviet Union's absence was a high-level calculation to secure a strategic advantage over Europe by inducing U.S. participation in the Korean War. However, we know that this was an astonishing providence to save free democratic Korea according to God's will. In fact, a behind-the-scenes story has recently been revealed, that Billy Graham, a strong Christian leader in the United States, directly called Truman immediately after the outbreak of the war and requested immediate deployment to save Korea, which had many Christians and practiced democracy.





General MacArthur was 70 years old, and a veteran of many battles. He conceived the Incheon Landing Operation, which involved attacking behind enemy lines and striking at the core of the North Korean forces. It was a historic operation on a grand scale, mobilizing 75,000 troops on 262 war ships. The odds of success were said to be one in 5,000. The sea near Incheon was shallow and littered with rocks, and the difference in tides made it impossible to land directly from the ship, so small boats had to be used. If the North Korean forces had known their plans in advance, the entire force could have been drowned in the sea without a chance to retreat. In utmost secrecy, some South Korean soldiers were deployed as an intelligence unit to secure the landing point in advance. After exchanging signals, they succeeded in the landing operation, as fast as lightning, and marched straight to Seoul, reclaiming the city in just 13 days. The day was September 28, 1950. Seoul was reclaimed three months after it was taken. General MacArthur continued to advance northward to annihilate the communist forces in the second phase, marching all the way to the Yalu River.

Meanwhile, U.N. forces under the command of Army Lieutenant Alexander Haig were also deployed in the Hungnam Operation, evacuating military forces along with tens of thousands of North Korean civilians. At that time, True Father, who was in the Communist-controlled Hungnam Prison, was miraculously liberated on October 14, 1950. Later, Haig retired as an Army General and became U.S. Secretary of State. When he passed away, the True Parents gave him the blessing of holding a special Seonghwa ceremony. As the continental chairman at the time, I attended the ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery with representatives of the True Family and The Washington Times.









Within a month of the Incheon Landing Operation, General MacArthur had control over almost of North Korea. However, with the arrival of one million Chinese troops to support the North Koreans, the U.N. forces had to retreat. In the fierce battles that continued for three years and one month, approximately four million people from both sides were killed, injured, or went missing before a ceasefire was agreed upon on July 27, 1953. Around 2.1 million foreign soldiers fought with the U.N. forces during the war; 1.8 million were American soldiers. There were 41,000 casualties among the U.N. forces; 37,000 of them were American. Sixteen countries sent troops to the U.N. forces, six countries provided medical support, and 41 countries provided material, for a total of 63 countries that helped South Korea. Most of the logistical support in this process was from Japan.

On the other hand, North Korea received various weapons from the Soviet Union at the beginning of the war, and China later sent one million troops to help North Korea with human wave tactics.

Among the Korean people, ten million families were separated by the division into North and South. Most of the first generation are dying of old age, with an unfulfilled longing to see their family members.

Thus, the Korean War was another World War that cannot be forgotten. At that time, True Mother became a refugee with Grandmother Hong, and crossed the Han River to safety with the help of the U.N. forces. U.N. troops were essential to protect the True Parents. When viewed providentially, the Korean War was the final battle where the conflict between Cain and Abel that started in the Garden of Eden played out as God's side and Satan's side. It was a fight between good and evil, a fight between theism and atheism, and a confrontation between democracy and communism.







Therefore, this Korean Peninsula is the final battleground in God's providence.

When we focus on Vision 2025 for the Korean Peninsula, it has to be the pivotal point when the divided North and South embark on the path of unification. The year 2025 marks the 80th anniversary of Korean liberation. Many prophets say that the clouds of unification will be full over the Korean Peninsula in 2025.

The problem is the process and method of unification.

Right now, the South and North are in a state of high tension, facing off against each other. North Korea is pouring all its energy into developing long-range missiles and nuclear weapons, even as its people starve to death, while South Korea's economy ranks among the top 10 in the world, and its trade volume is ranked sixth. In 2019, South Korea became only the seventh country to join the OECD's 30-50 Club (countries with per capita income of US\$30,000 and a population over 50 million).

The personal income difference between South and North Korea is 30:1, and the difference in gross domestic product (GDP) is 59:1. In the midst of this, North Korea is spending 26.4% of its national budget on its military, and South Korea is pouring 2.7% of its GDP into defense. There are studies suggesting that if both sides were to ease tensions and convert their military expenditures into production and infrastructure, approximately 2,000 trillion won could be saved by 2050, which would solve problems such as North Korea's food shortages and the need to advance its industrialization. \mathcal{F}



The 2023 Peace Road Unity March: A Global Endeavor for Unity and Peace

Marking the 70th anniversary of the Armistice Agreement, the 'Peace Road Unity March' was initiated to commemorate the valorous sacrifices of soldiers from 22 nations. Emblematic of aspirations for both the reunification of the Korean Peninsula and worldwide peace, this monumental event simultaneously unfolded across 160 countries, engaging around 400,000 global participants.

n Iceland, under the banner of 'Efforts to Address Climate Crisis', a poignant 15 km march toward a volcano was staged on July 21st. This assembly not only facilitated dialogues among diverse groups but also amplified the shared anxieties and despair induced by climate change, kindling a renewed consciousness about the burgeoning environmental crisis.

Shifting to Asunción, Paraguay, a 'Walking for Peace' campaign was done on the 12th of June. Esteemed members from institutions like the Universal Peace Federation (UPF), Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP), Collegiate Association for the Research of Principles (CARP), and International Association of Youth and Students for Peace (IAYSP) graced the occasion. The spotlight was on the ideals championed by Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, envisioning a heavenly unified Korea and a harmonized world. Participants exuded optimism, fervently wishing for an everlasting commitment to global peace and a sustained drive towards achieving it.





Meanwhile, in Mexico City, the atmosphere was electrifying as the 9th edition of the Peace Road event took center stage on June 13th, this time at the iconic Azteca Stadium. This bicycle-led peace expedition, themed 'Lead the Way to Peace', drew over 300 enthusiasts, including delegates from Mexico City's UPF, FFWPU, WFWP, and the IAYSP. Guided by the poignant mantra, 'Peace Begins With Me', and backed by the unwavering support of local law enforcement and administrative agencies, the event unfolded seamlessly.

The 2023 Peace Road Unity March, spanning Iceland, Paraguay, and Mexico City, culminated as a resounding success. Navigating environmental and geographical adversities, participants wholeheartedly embraced the ethos of the Peace Road, victoriously culminating the journey with a united spirit across regions. \mathcal{P}

A Tribute to Our Missionaries of 1975

his historic day in
February 1975 is forever
engraved in our hearts
and minds, as it was
the time, we received
instructions from our True
Parents to send missionaries
from Germany to 120 nations1
within six weeks. The given
number of 120 is symbolic, as
explained in detail in the Divine

Principle. All missionaries were supposed to be in their respective countries on 1st May 1975, which seemed totally impossible, given each nation's different situations and legal requirements. But the word 'impossible' did not exist for our True Father.

One missionary from each of the former enemy nations of Japan, the United States and Germany, were to form a trinity and work together as a team. Since True Parents were living in the United States at that time, True Father addressed the American missionaries. His words were meant for the Japanese and German missionaries as well: "As I send you to many nations, our message and our way of life will be spread to every corner of the earth. You are to serve the people of your nation. What has been done for others will remain and always be remembered by future generations." He urged them: "If you succeed to unite as Japanese, American and Germans, your work will be blessed by God and crowned with success. If the three of you are totally united, God will absolutely help you, and your nation will develop. If you don't, you will never make progress." These young missionaries were the representatives of True Parents.

Their focus was on the principle of true love and service, thus achieving the unification of all people as children of God, regardless of skin colour, nationality and religion. True Father emphasized: "God wishes to visit every corner of the world He created. He especially wants to visit those places where His children are

sincerely preparing the foundation of loyalty. As God's children, therefore, you must pioneer the end of the world and invite Him." At that time, my husband Paul and I were stationed in Pasadena, California, supporting the IOWC2 activities in the United States.

Completely unexpected, we received the call from our True Parents, entrusting us with this historic undertaking to send German missionaries to all corners of the world. My immediate reaction was a sense of concern and a tremendous responsibility for the lives of these brothers and sisters. They lacked life experience, were so young in age and young in our movement. As we have worked in different nations around the world ourselves, we knew what was awaiting them and wanted to prepare them as much as possible. However, this was God's call through our True Parents, and prayed that He would grant our precious brothers and sisters the protection they so desperately needed and only He could provide.

When Paul and I arrived at our seminar centre, Neumühle, our young missionaries to be were already assembled, and my feelings for each of them were overwhelming. We spent these few days with unforgettable meetings as a group and personally with brothers and sisters.

We are deeply grateful to Rita and her team, who reliably and tirelessly took care of all necessary preparations, a monumental effort in all respects.

To the missionaries, we stressed the importance of immediately communicating their arrival, staying in regular contact with us, never exposing themselves to dangerous situations alone, and turning to the respective German Embassy for help, if necessary.

Father's instructions for the missionaries to arrive in their countries by 1st May 1975 were taken very seriously by Paul – as always. Therefore, we are grateful that all German missionaries were on their way by the end of April and were the first to arrive in their mission countries.

For them to feel connected with True Parents and our worldwide activities, we sent monthly letters and photos by airmail. Our prayers and love have always accompanied each one of them. Unfortunately, it was not possible for Paul and myself to personally send off the missionaries, as we were entrusted with another important responsibility in the United States and had to leave earlier. The last gathering in our training centre was a moving farewell. Many tears were shed. While singing the song we knew so well, it took on a much deeper meaning for all of us.

"The heart of my country beckons to me To fill its emptiness.

My Father long has spoken to me His desire this land to bless.

He sends me on to life unknown To work in a far-off place.

He loves that land before I come, And through me, He'll give it grace..."

Once in their countries, the missionaries persevered bravely despite many hardships and dangers, embraced the different cultures and languages and laid a solid foundation for their country's future. We could only



accompany them with innumerable, tearful prayers.

Their guardian angels have certainly had to work overtime to protect their lives. After their Marriage Blessing in 1982, either in Madison Square Garden, New York or Korea, the missionaries returned to their mission countries and eventually started their family life.

They gave birth to children, sometimes under challenging conditions, be it in Africa, the Middle East, Central and South America, or Asia. Our courageous missionaries are and always will be dear to our hearts. We tried to keep in touch with them, even when we were officially no longer responsible for them.

Paul and I are eternally grateful to our brave missionaries for answering the call of our Heavenly Parent and our True Parents for their tireless commitment, their deep faith, devotion, sacrifice, and their life of selfless love in service to God's children worldwide.

We especially thank our Heavenly Parent for all His protection and blessings. To this day, we pray for the missionaries and their families. May their unique examples of service and dedication inspire future generations to participate in building a peaceful world. \mathcal{F}
